

ROUTE SYMBOLS

- A good route wich is well worth climbing.
- $\{2\}$ A very good route, one of the best on the crag.
- A brilliant route, one of the best in the area.
- A recent route, or one for which there is little information about quality and/or grade.
- Technical climbing requiring good balance and technique, or complex and tricky moves.
- Powerfull climbing; Roofs, steep rock, low lockoffs or long moves off small holds.
- Sustained climbing; either lots of hard moves or steep rock giving pumpy climbing
- Fingery climbing with significant small holds on the hard section.
- Slopy climbing with slopers on the hard section
- A dyno is required. Usually only used for boulder problems.
- A long reach is helpful, or even essential, for one or more of the moves.
- Loose rock may be encountered
- A small or full rack of gear is required.

CRAG SYMBOLS

- Angle of the approach walk to crag with approximate time.
 - Approximate time the crag is in direct sun shine.
- This crag is usually sheltered from wind
- Takes long to dry after ra
- This crag has one or more multipitch routes.

GRADE COLORS

- 1 4+ or below
- 2 5- to 6-
- 3 6 to 7+
- 4 8- and above

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ESPEDALEN

Espedalen offers a family-friendly well bolted sports climbing crag with vertical clmbing on good friction granite and easy access to the top of the cliff for putting up top rope. A headwall with a width of nearly 100 meters offers more than 25 routes between 15 and 35 meters in length. The accessibility and it's two fireplaces makes Espedalen one of Bø's most popular crags, and it's widely used for both climbing courses and local events. That being said, the quality and abundance of routes stand on its own, and offers superb techy climbing in a variety of grades, which make Espedalen a must-visit in Bø.

STARED ROUTES






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Getting there:

From Bø, head in direction of Seljord on RV36. About 3 km out of town, take a left turn on to the gravel road named Espedalsveien. Drive to the end of the Espedalsveien, park at the little pitch next to the farm. Pay 20 kr in parking fee by cash or by VIPPS.




Approach: 5 minutes

From the parking, cross the road and walk towards the forest. Do not walk on the field, follow the trail around it. Upon reaching the woods, a red blazed trail will lead you through a small forest patch to the base of the wall.
























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
